



OUR PLAN TO SAVE A TREE



Once you have found a local tree that needs your help, follow the plan below and work together to save that tree!

Step	Action	Details
1	Observe and Document	Take pictures of the tree and note down its location. Observe any signs of distress, such as wilting leaves or damaged bark.
2	Talk to Your Teacher	Share your findings with your teacher and explain your concern for the tree's health. Teachers can guide and support you in taking action.
3	Raise Awareness	Prepare a short presentation to share with your classmates during class or a school assembly. Explain why the tree is essential and why it needs help.
