Things to Teach

Talk to your class about the importance of water.
Ask them to draw 10 places they might find water.

Invite the group to sit close to you and use your wheel to explain that water works in a cycle. Show them how the water moves from one place to another.

Explain to the children that they are going to make their own water wheel. Send them back to their groups with the materials needed and walk around the class helping those children that need it.

Once the children have completed making their wheel, ask them to use it to explain the water cycle to a partner.

Bring the children back into a group and ask each of the groups to show their work to the class and explain how the work made them feel. Ask the children some questions about the water cycle to revise their learning. Well done!!!
