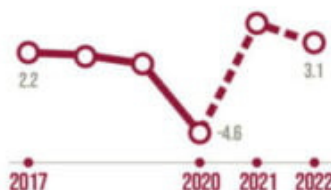


1.6 BILLION INFORMAL ECONOMY WORKERS
