Exchange cultural information, collaborate on projects, and build lasting friendships.</p>	<p>Local History Documentary: Team up with a local historical society to create a documentary about your community's history. Interview older residents, collect stories, and present your findings.</p>	<p>Local Wildlife Survey: Collaborate with a local wildlife organisation to conduct a survey of local wildlife. Record your findings and share them with the community to promote biodiversity awareness.</p>
