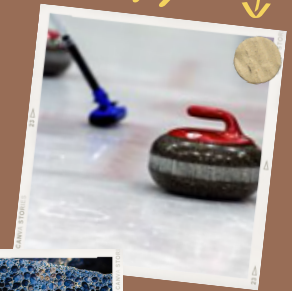

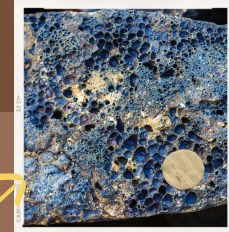

## IGNEOUS

Magma that is stored within the Earth,  
can sometimes escape and as  
volcanoes erupt, they release lava.  
When this lava or magma cools down,  
this forms igneous rock. Igneous rock  
contains random crystal shapes.
