## Job Description

### Class Manager

The class manager's job is to help all of the teams complete their tasks on time and help them if required. You will be in charge of collecting everyone's different parts and putting it all together ready for upload.

### Front Cover

The front cover team will need to design a creative and attractive front cover and title that will make people want to read more about the animals in your country. This team must work together to negotiate and have a creative spirit.

### Blurb

The team in charge of writing the blurb will need to design a back cover and put it all together in a beautiful way to summarize what the book is about and how it is to be used. You will need to make sure you communicate with the front cover team.

### About the Author

Your job will be to tell the world about your class, your school and the wonderful work that you are doing to make the world a better place. Tell everyone where you're from and the school you attend. You'll also need to include a photo or drawing of your class.

### Activity Page

Your job will be to create an activity page where children around the world can use the knowledge in your book to complete a special task that will help them to make the world a little better. Your activity page must only be 1 page long and be well designed.

### Dedication Page
