Learn about different peace symbols from around the world and incorporate them into the garden.</p>	<p>Inclusive Sports Day: Plan and participate in an inclusive sports day where everyone, regardless of ability, age, or position can compete in fun and fair games.</p>	<p>Legal System Field Trip: Arrange a field trip to a local courthouse or parliament. Students can see the legal system in action and meet professionals who work in justice-related fields.</p>	<p>Conflict Resolution Station: Set up a designated area where students can come if they have a problem. Trained peer mediators help them resolve conflicts peacefully.</p>	<p>Justice Journals: Grab a journal and start documenting any instances of fairness or unfairness you see around you. Reflect on these situations and come up with ideas on how to make things better.</p>
<p>Human Rights Poster Campaign: Design posters that highlight important human rights issues and put them up around the school. Let's raise awareness and educate everyone about justice and equality.</p>	<p>Peace Pledge Wall: Create a wall filled with peace and Write your personal pledge to promote peace and justice in your daily life and display it on our Peace Pledge Wall. Get the whole school to follow you by doing the same.</p>	<p>Letters for Change: Write letters to local government officials or organisations about justice issues that matter to you. Your voice can help bring about positive changes in our community.</p>	<p>Classroom Constitution: Work together to write a classroom constitution. Include rules and principles that ensure everyone is treated fairly and with respect.</p>	<p>Portrait Painting of a Justice Activist: Choose a famous justice activist, like Rosa Parks or Nelson Mandela, and paint their portrait. Research their life and achievements to inspire your artwork.</p>
		<p>Justice Role Models Interviews: Interview local justice role models, such as police officers, judges, or community leaders.
