Learn about their important roles in our ecosystems. ✓</p>	<p><b>Seed Bomb Workshop:</b> Learn how to make seed bombs with native plant seeds and distribute them to help our plants grow in the right places. ✓</p>	<p><b>Nature Clean-Up Days:</b> Join in on clean-up days at nearby parks or forests. Learn about the impact of litter on our land ecosystems and help make a difference. ✓</p>	<p><b>Wildlife Observation:</b> Observe local wildlife and document your findings. Create a report highlighting why each species is important to our ecosystem. ✓</p>
<p><b>Seed-to-Tree Journey:</b> Grow a seed into a sapling and then replant it outdoors. Watch and learn how a tiny seed becomes a part of our ecosystem! ✓</p>	<p><b>Composting Workshop:</b> Discover how to compost and understand its benefits for the health of our soil and plants. Once you understand, start a composting club at school and encourage everyone to recycle their waste food. ✓</p>	<p><b>Ecosystem Model Projects:</b> Build a model of our local ecosystem. Show how different organisms live together and depend on each other. ✓</p>	<p><b>Recycled Art Competition:</b> Use recycled materials to create beautiful artworks. Show how recycling can help our environment and have fun being creative! ✓</p>	<p><b>Community Garden Project:</b> Let's start a garden at our school! You'll learn to grow native plants and understand their role in our local biodiversity. ✓</p>
