Hello from Gavin McCormack, and Richard Mills, the cofounders of Upschool. Over the next 17 pages,


has demonstrated their ability to create












Create 9 inspirational flashcards for children to learn about the wonders of the world. Once complete, colour them in and give them away to another school or class.




CREATE AN SDG#5 COMMUNITY LIBRARY



Below are six books that we have handpicked for our Gender Equality Community Library. Our library promotes both female and male characters.





SDG#7 PLAN A CYCLE TO SCHOOL DAY


We organised a day where everyone in the whole community used a sustainable way to travel to school to help save the planet.

MAKE AN SDG#8 CARD OF APPRECIATION


Find somebody who works very hard in your school and make a card to let them know how much you appreciate them. Then, spend a day helping them do their job and reflect on the experience.




SDG #12 PLANT A GIFT

12 RESPONSIBLE CONSUMPTION AND PRODUCTION

Plant a seed in a recylced coffee pot, take good care of it and give it away.

You'll Need

- A recycled coffee cup
- Potting soil
- A seed of your choice (e.g. a sunflower seed)
- A watering can or watering bottle








Step 1 - Fill the coffee cup with potting soil until it's about 2/3 full. Poke 3 holes in the bottom and make sure to leave enough room for the seed to set its roots. Step 3 - Water the soil until it is moist but not soaking wet. Use the watering can or watering bottle to avoid drowning the seed.



Step 5 - Check the plant each day, speak nicely to it and watch as the seed sprouts and grows into a beautiful plant!



Step 2 - Take the seed and place it on top of the soil in the coffee cup. Cover it with a thin layer of soil and tamp down gently.



Choose an animal in danger of extinction and create an information report about that animal. Use the report to educate others about the need to protect our most vulnerable species.







