1. CONDUCT YOUR RESEARCH

As you are going to be using the following resource to teach other children about the layers of the Earth. You will need to conduct detailed research before creating your Earth wheel.




2. CUT OUT YOUR 5 DISCS


Use the template provided to help you carefully cut out your 6 discs.

Each disk will represent a different layer and will need to be coloured correctly. Make sure they are proportionate in size the other layers.

3. COPY YOUR FACTS

From the research you have conducted, choose the most amazing fact to get your students excited. Carefully copy the mind-blowing fact onto your disk just underneath the name of the layer.





4. PUT IT ALL TOGETHER

Once your disks are all completed. Carefully line them all up and use a split pin to attach them all together. Finally test that all of your layers turn without any issues. You'll need a split pin.

5. TEACH OTHERS

When your Earth wheel is ready, it is then time to visit another class or a group of children and start to teach them about the wonders of the Earth beneath our feet. You may wish to give your earth wheel to your students, or allow them to create their own.
